International Toast

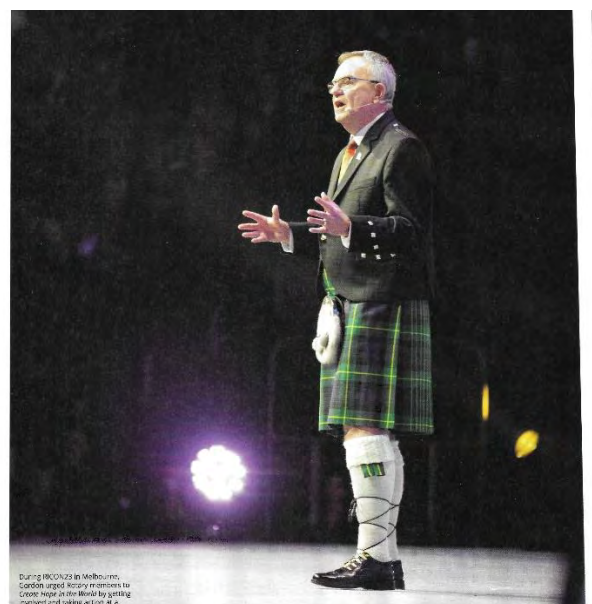
Past President Ken proposed a toast to the Rotary Club of South Queensferry which is the home club of current RI President Gordon R McNally.

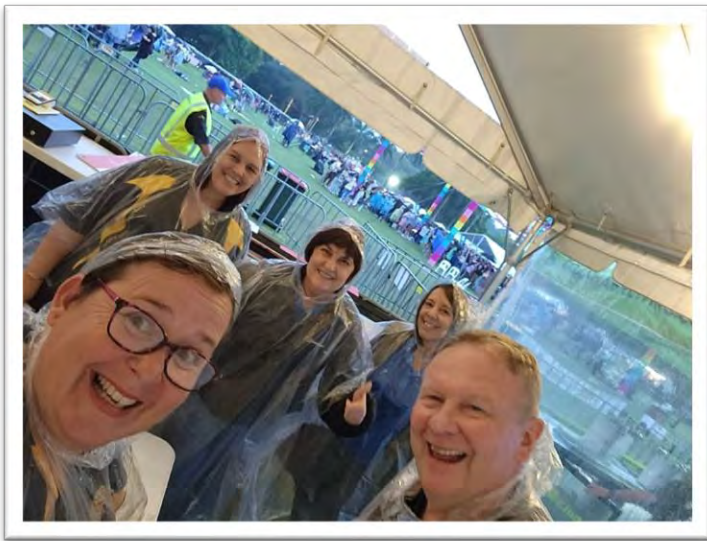

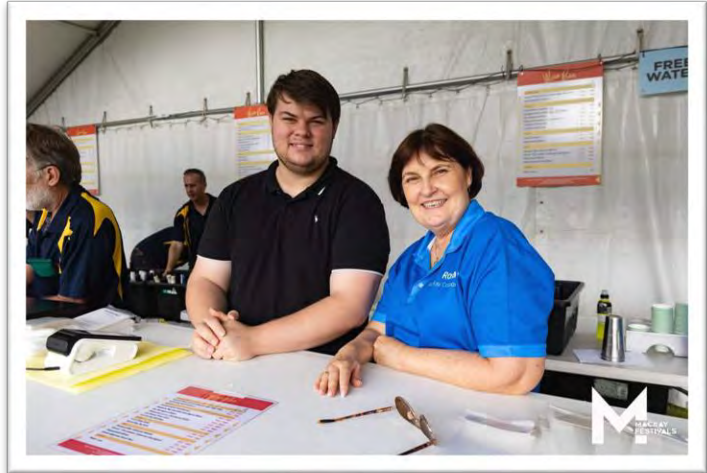
